- Check your fridge before shopping and only buy what you can eat



- Drain liquid from raw wastes



- Dispose of unused foods at collection centers

- For mixed paper, separate into recyclable magazines/books/-mixed papers



- For items with a recyclable plastic mark, separate into plastic containers and packaging

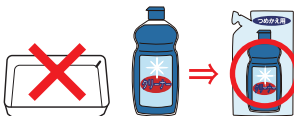


- Dispose of small electrical appliances in the collection box

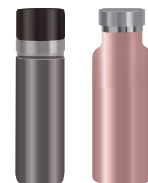

Warning Labels

Recyclables and waste not collected due to not being in designated collection bags, incorrect collection day, not being separated or other reason will be left with a warning label like the one on the right attached to it. When this warning label has been attached, the check mark indicates the reason so confirm the reason and dispose of the waste correctly.

At that time, do not try to peel the warning label off. Simply write a large "X" across the label when disposing.

Recycling and Waste Disposal Locations

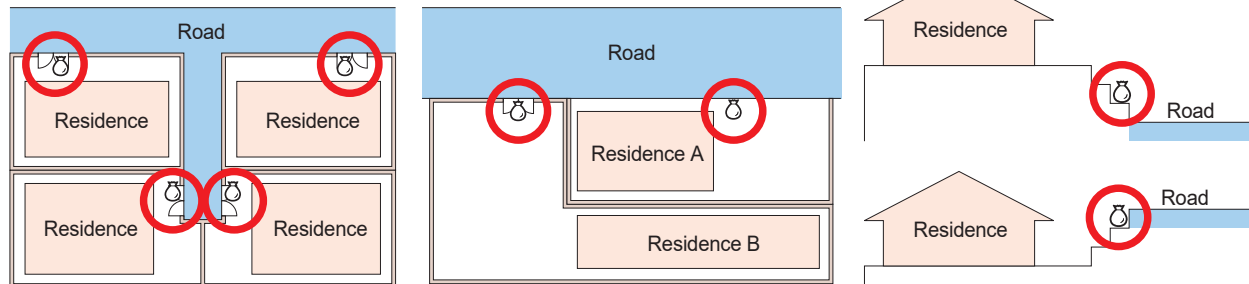
When starting collection such as when moving to a new home or when a new multi-unit residence has been built, contact the Resource Recycling Section two days before the start of collection not including weekends, holidays or New Years' holidays.

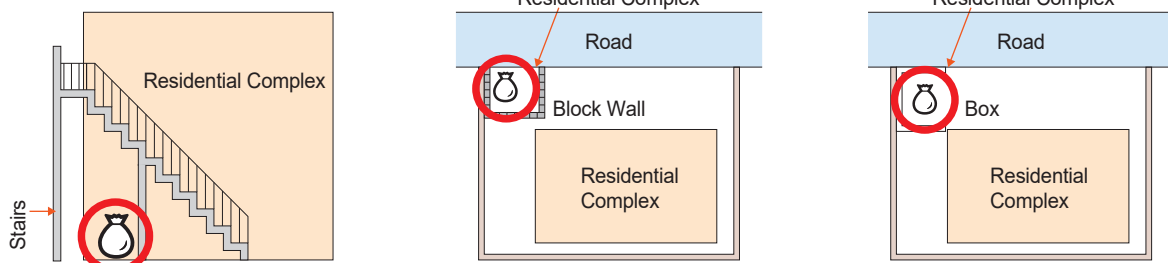
- * Plastic buckets, nets and other containers can be used to effectively prevent access by birds or animals.
- * Old plastic buckets or baskets may break during collection. Thank you for regularly replacing with new items.
- * Disposing of waste on the road may cause an impediment to traffic. Always set it out within the property limits of your residence.

Persons Living in Residential Complexes



Dispose of waste at the central disposal location within the property limits. When creating a new central disposal location, ensure the space can be easily checked during collection such as **beside the road in the property limits**.

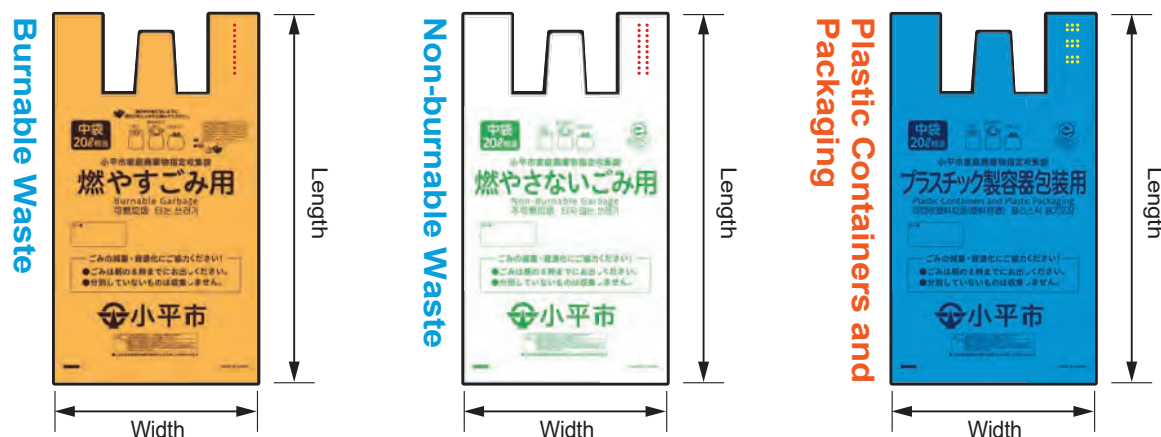


Designated Collection Bags

Burnable waste, non-burnable waste and plastic containers and packaging are collected in designated collection bags. These items will not be collected if placed out in bags other than the designated collection bags.

Purchase the designated collection bags at stores, supermarkets, drugstores, convenience stores and other locations in Kodaira or neighboring cities.

* Burnable waste and non-burnable waste use different bags.

* To assist persons with visual impairment in telling them apart, the grips on one side of the bags for burnable waste are embossed with a single vertical dashed line, the grips on one side of the bags for non-burnable waste are embossed with a double vertical line, and the grips on one side of the bags for plastic containers and packaging are embossed with three 1cm squares arranged vertically (the images above have been altered to demonstrate the pattern on the grips on the bags).

* Various kinds of support are available to eliminate or reduce the cost of the bags such as for persons receiving social welfare or households receiving child support subsidies. For details, information is available on the City website or by contacting the Resource Recycling Section.

● Always tie the top after putting recyclables and waste in bags to prevent visibility of the contents.

* To prevent bags from bursting, avoid filling with more weight than can be easily held in one hand.

* The designated bags for burnable waste are treated so contents cannot be seen by crows. If the opening is not closed, this effect will be lessened. Always tie off the opening so the contents cannot be seen.

● Waste that does not fit in designated collection bags must be disposed of as oversized waste.

* Non-burnable waste shaped like a pole such as an umbrella (less than 1m) should be placed in a designated bag that fits more than half of it inside and placed out ensuring that the opening is tied off.

● Disposing of a large amount of recyclables or waste all at once can interfere with collection on that day. Consider ways you can reduce the amount of recyclables and waste and plan your waste disposal (aim for up to 5 bags or bundles per type per collection).

On the opposite side of the opening in the outer bag that they are sold in 10 to a set, to assist persons with visual impairment in telling them apart, the one for burnable waste has one 7mm hole, the one for non-burnable waste has two 7mm holes, and the one for plastic containers and packaging has three 7mm holes (the images above have been altered to demonstrate the holes on the bags).

Disposing of Recyclables

[Collection Frequency:
once every 2 weeks]

Bottles [beverages, alcohols, seasonings, food products, cosmetics jars, medicine jars, etc.]



1 Remove cap and lid (labels do not need to be removed).



2 Empty the contents and gently rinse with water. (It cannot be recycled if dirty or contaminated.)



3 Place separately into transparent or semi-transparent bags. * It is possible to dispose of these items by placing directly in baskets or buckets. Take measures to ensure they are not spread by strong winds.

Dispose of the following items as non-burnable waste

Broken bottles, bottles with oil or otherwise unable to be cleaned, bottles for agricultural chemicals or other hazardous substances, bottles sold individually (such as bottles for making umeshu), heat resistant glass and glass dishes

Caution

- Caps and lids should be separated based on their material into cans, plastic containers and packaging or non-burnable waste.
- It is not necessary to remove cap rings or inner seals.
- Do not put cigarette butts or other foreign objects in bottles.
- Return beer bottles or milk bottles to the place of purchase when possible.

Cans [beverages, snacks, food cans, seaweed, etc.]



1 Empty the contents and gently rinse with water. (It cannot be recycled if dirty or contaminated.)



2 Place separately into transparent or semi-transparent bags. (Cans may be crushed.)

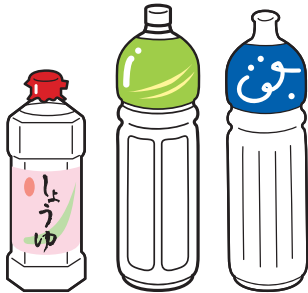
* It is possible to dispose of these items by placing directly in baskets or buckets. Take measures to ensure they are not spread by strong winds.

Caution

- Cans for oils or other difficult to remove substance, paint cans or itto cans (cube shaped 18l cans) are non-burnable waste.
- For spray cans and gas cartridge cannisters, see page 10 and dispose of in a separate bag on the day for collecting hazardous resources.
- Do not put cigarette butts or other foreign objects in cans.

Separate by type and place in transparent or semi-transparent bags (shopping bags are allowed) for disposal. For bottles, cans and PET bottles, these can also be collected at the stores on page 14.

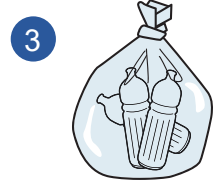
PET Bottles [soft drinks, soy sauce, alcohols, mirin, etc.]



1 Remove caps and labels.



2 Empty the contents and gently rinse with water. (It cannot be recycled if dirty or contaminated.)



3 Place PET bottles separately in transparent or semi-transparent bags.

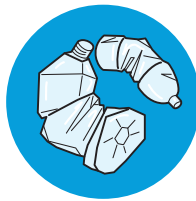
* It is possible to dispose of these items by placing directly in baskets or buckets. Take measures to ensure they are not spread by strong winds.



It is not necessary to remove cap rings or inner seals.




Caps, lids and labels should be disposed of as plastic containers and packaging.



PET bottles may be crushed.
* If cut, they cannot be used as resources.

Caution

- Do not mix with items other than PET bottles.
- Do not put cigarette butts or other foreign objects in PET bottles.
-  PET bottles for foreign products that do not have the PET1 mark are burnable waste.
- PET bottles that are cut for crafts or some other reason are burnable waste.

Metallic Pots, Kettles and Frying Pans



- Place pots, kettles, frying pans, bowls and sieves (made of metal) in transparent or semi-transparent bags.

- Glass lids are non-burnable waste.

* It is possible to dispose of these items by placing directly in baskets or buckets. Take measures to ensure they are not spread by strong winds.

Caution

- If the main part is made of metals, it can be recycled even with wooden or plastic patterns or handles.
- Items where the main part is not metallic (such as ceramic pots) are non-burnable waste.

Do you want to start group collection of recyclables?

(Paper, cloth, bottles, cans, etc.)

- Groups that collect recyclables such as local neighborhood associations or children's clubs can receive support based on the amount collected.
- Registration is required. Please contact the Resource Recycling Section.
- Do not collect recyclables placed in disposal locations without permission.

Spray Cans, Gas Cartridge Can

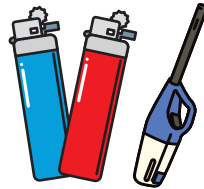


- 1 Fully use contents (opening a hole is not necessary).
- 2 Place spray cans and gas cartridge cans in transparent or semi-transparent bags.

- Remove plastic caps and nozzles and dispose of as plastic containers and packaging



Lighters



- 1 Fully use contents.
- 2 Place separately into transparent or semi-transparent bags.

Batteries [disposable batteries, etc.]

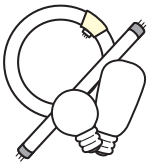


- Place separately into transparent or semi-transparent bags.



- Always remove from toys or electronic appliances that will be disposed of.
- Take small rechargeable batteries to collection boxes at stores with recycling programs (electronics stores). (See page 13.) For automobile batteries, take them to stores that sell automotive batteries.

Fluorescent Tubes

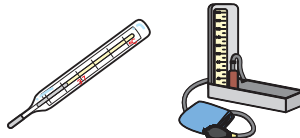


- Place in empty boxes or take similar measures to prevent breaking when disposing. (This is to prevent injury by passers-by or collection workers.)

- Round-shaped bulbs and fluorescent lamps with bulbs are recyclable.
- Incandescent bulbs and LED bulbs are non-burnable waste.

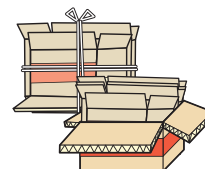


Mercury Thermometers, Mercury Blood Pressure Gauges



- 1 Place thermometers in a case.
 - 2 Place separately into transparent or semi-transparent bags.
- Electronic thermometers and electronic blood pressure gauges are either small appliances (page 19) or non-burnable waste.

Cardboard



- Tie with a package knot (do not use duct tape) or dispose of with only cardboard.

- Waxed, or gold or silver foiled cardboard is burnable waste.
- Here, cardboard only refers to items with a wavelike cross section.



Newspaper



- Tie with a package knot or place in a paper bag. (Do not use duct tape.)
- Advertisements folded into newspaper can be disposed of with the newspaper. When only advertisements, dispose of as mixed papers.
- When requesting the newspaper company to pick up recycled newspaper, attach a notice on the front of the newspaper to make it clear.

Futons [cotton, wool, artificial fibers, down]

- Tie with a package knot when disposing.



- Quilted items are burnable waste.



- Urethane and other mattresses are oversized waste.

Dispose of the following items as burnable waste

* Waste that does not fit in designated collection bags is oversized waste

Kitchen mats, bath mats, cushions, zabuton, pillows, quilted items (such as kotatsu covers, etc.), oil stained or very dirty with urine, etc.

Do not dispose of futon or old cloth on rainy days.
Futons or old cloth placed out on rainy days is treated as burnable waste.

* Even a small amount of moisture can cause mold preventing reuse.

Magazines, Books, Mixed Papers



- Tie with a package knot or place in a paper bag. (Do not use duct tape.)
- Find out how to make paper bags on the Kodaira City web-site.
- Kodaira City Recycle Center collects unneeded paper bags (that can be used) and distributes paper bags for free (subject to availability).
- Place into transparent or semi-transparent bags if you do not have a paper bag.

* Sizes similar to a business card or larger can be recycled.

* Remove foreign matter such as cellophane, plastic or metal (clips), etc.

Caution

Dispose of the following papers as burnable waste (These negatively impact the quality of recycled paper)

- **Items with non-paper elements attached.**
 - ▶ Cellophane, plastic, metal, laminated paper, adhesive post card
- **Items with special treatments (waterproofing, etc.)**
 - ▶ Paper cups, cooking sheets, carbon papers, heat-sensitive paper (receipts), textile transfer paper (iron print paper), foam paper (paper for braille, etc.), photographs
- **Items that are dirty or scented.**
 - ▶ Scented paper such as detergent or incense (paper boxes for powder soap, etc.)

Shredder Waste



- Place separately into transparent or semi-transparent bags. (Shredded papers use a separate recycling process.)
- Dispose of on the same day as magazines, books, mixed papers.

* Post cards are collected at the permanent collection boxes available at the Resource Recycling Section counter as well as at City Hall and the Tobu and Seibu Branch Offices for your convenience.

* Paper cartons and milk cartons are collected at the locations on page 14. Wash, open and dry before disposal.



Old Cloth [used clothing/cloth, stuffed toys, bags, hats, neckties, belts]



- Place together into transparent or semi-transparent bags. (It is not necessary to separate used clothing, used cloth, stuffed toys, etc.)

* You may also tie with a package knot or place in a paper bag.

Caution

- Items will be reused inside or outside of Japan, so leave buttons, fasteners and other pieces attached and dispose of as clean as possible (some wrinkles and small holes are acceptable).
- Towels, handkerchiefs, sheets and curtains are also recyclable.
- Old articles of leather or synthetic leather are also recyclable.
- Dirty items, ripped items or broken items are burnable waste.
- Underwear, cloth diapers, diaper covers and yarn balls are burnable waste.

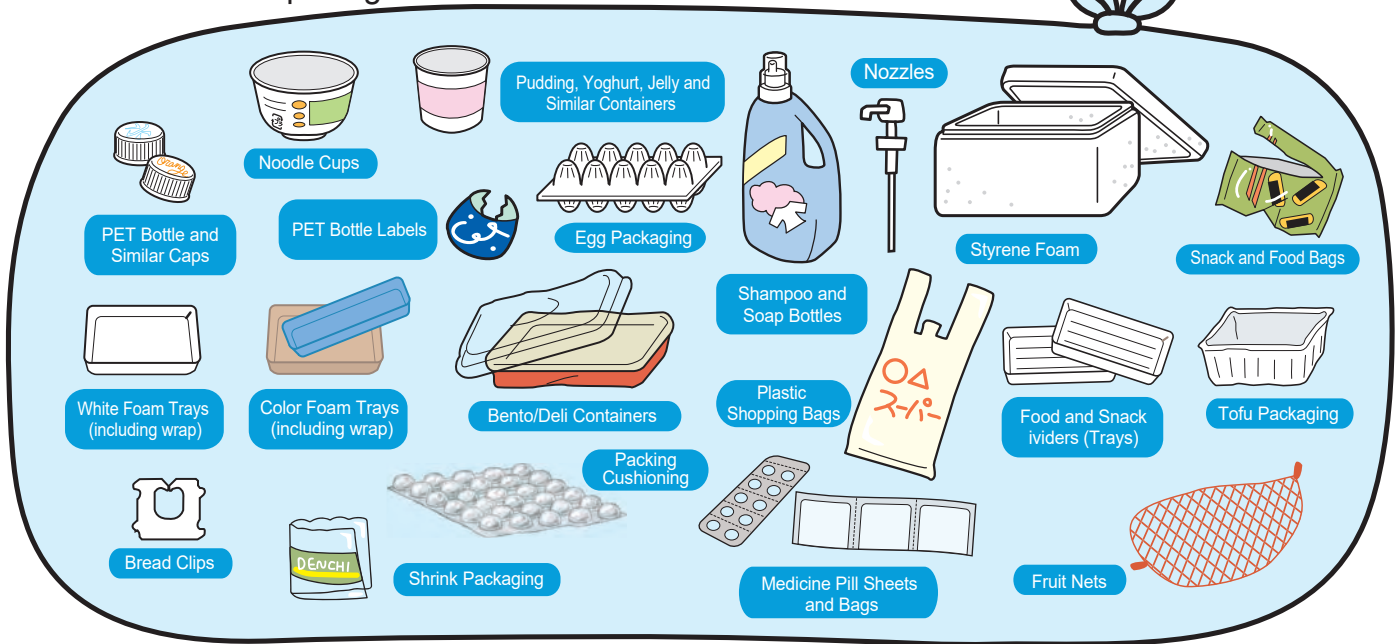
Disposing of Plastic Containers and Packaging

Place in
blue bags for
disposal.



Plastic containers and packaging includes trays, bottles, packing, noodle cups, bento containers, caps, shopping bags, candy wrappers and other similar items.

Empty the contents and gently rinse with water to clean and remove foreign matter. (It does not need to be washed with soap.) Cut or break down when disposing. Labels on containers may be left on while disposing.



Caution

- Dispose of dirty items as burnable waste. If it can be cleaned, the item can be plastic containers and packaging.
- Items that are not containers or packaging, even if they are also plastic, are not included in this category. Do not put such items in these bags.
- Batteries, lighters, sharp objects, syringes and similar objects may cause injury or accidents. Do not put such items in these bags.
- Directly place plastic containers and packaging into the designated collection bags.
Do not double bag (as shown at right). * This will result in extra work to remove bags at the recycling plant.
- IV tubes, urine collection packs and other plastic medical wastes are burnable waste. (See page 17 for details.)

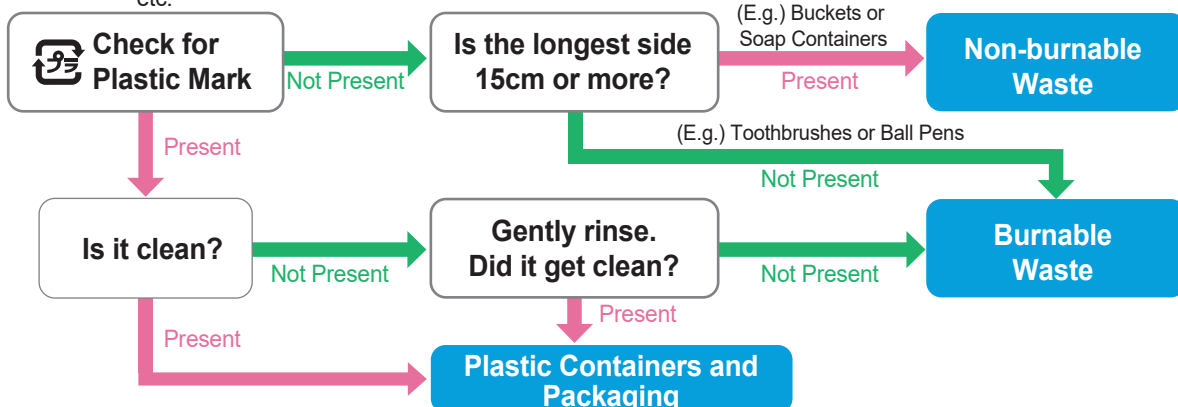


Separating and Disposing of Plastics



This mark is shown on plastic containers and packaging but may indicate the entire unit without indications for caps and other parts.

Other articles are plastic containers and packaging but may not have the mark including containers for products, packing wrapping products, styrene foam, fruit nets, plastic shopping bags, packing cushioning, etc.



For trays (white, colored) and similar articles use the stores or central collection locations given page 14.

Examples of Unrecyclable Dirtiness

In the following cases, dispose of dirty items as burnable waste.



● No traces of washing



● Contents remain
(it is difficult to remove contents)

Caution

- Do not put used small rechargeable batteries including lithium ion batteries in the bags for plastic containers and packaging. Even if the battery is encased in plastic, it cannot be disposed of plastic containers and packaging. Many fires occur in collection vehicles and recycling plants.



Treatment of Small Rechargeable Batteries including Lithium Ion Batteries

Box Collection

Collection is available at boxes installed at recycling shops (electronics stores), City Hall, Kodaira City Recycle Center, Tobu/Seibu Branch Offices, libraries (Central, Kihei, Kamijuku, Tsuda, Onuma), and Nakamachi Terrace. (Only when open)



Caution

- Remove used small rechargeable batteries from device and use vinyl tape to insulate the terminals. Dry cells, button batteries, mobile charging batteries, cellphone batteries and e-tobacco are not included. Cellphone batteries and e-tobacco products should be brought to sales locations.

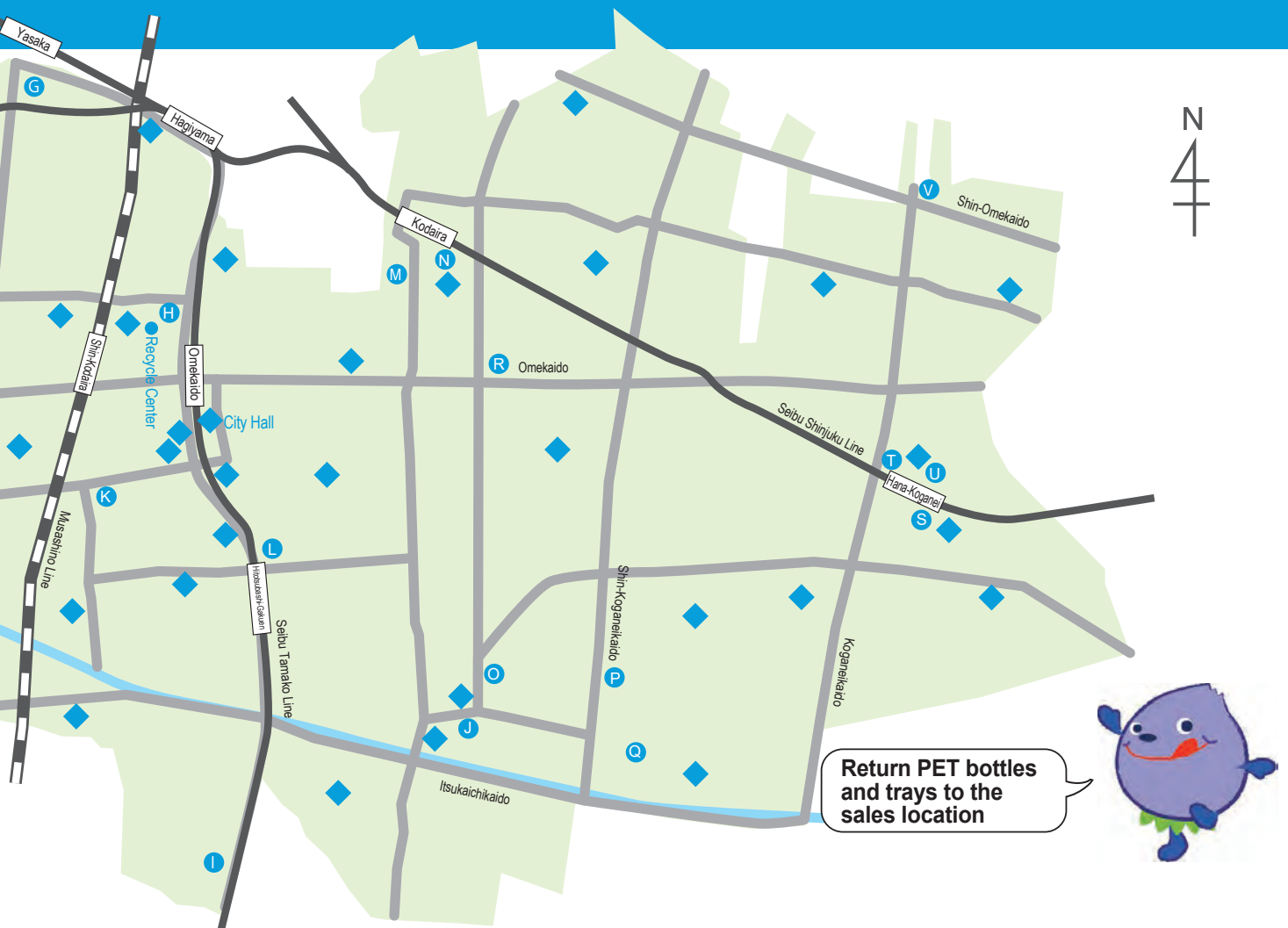

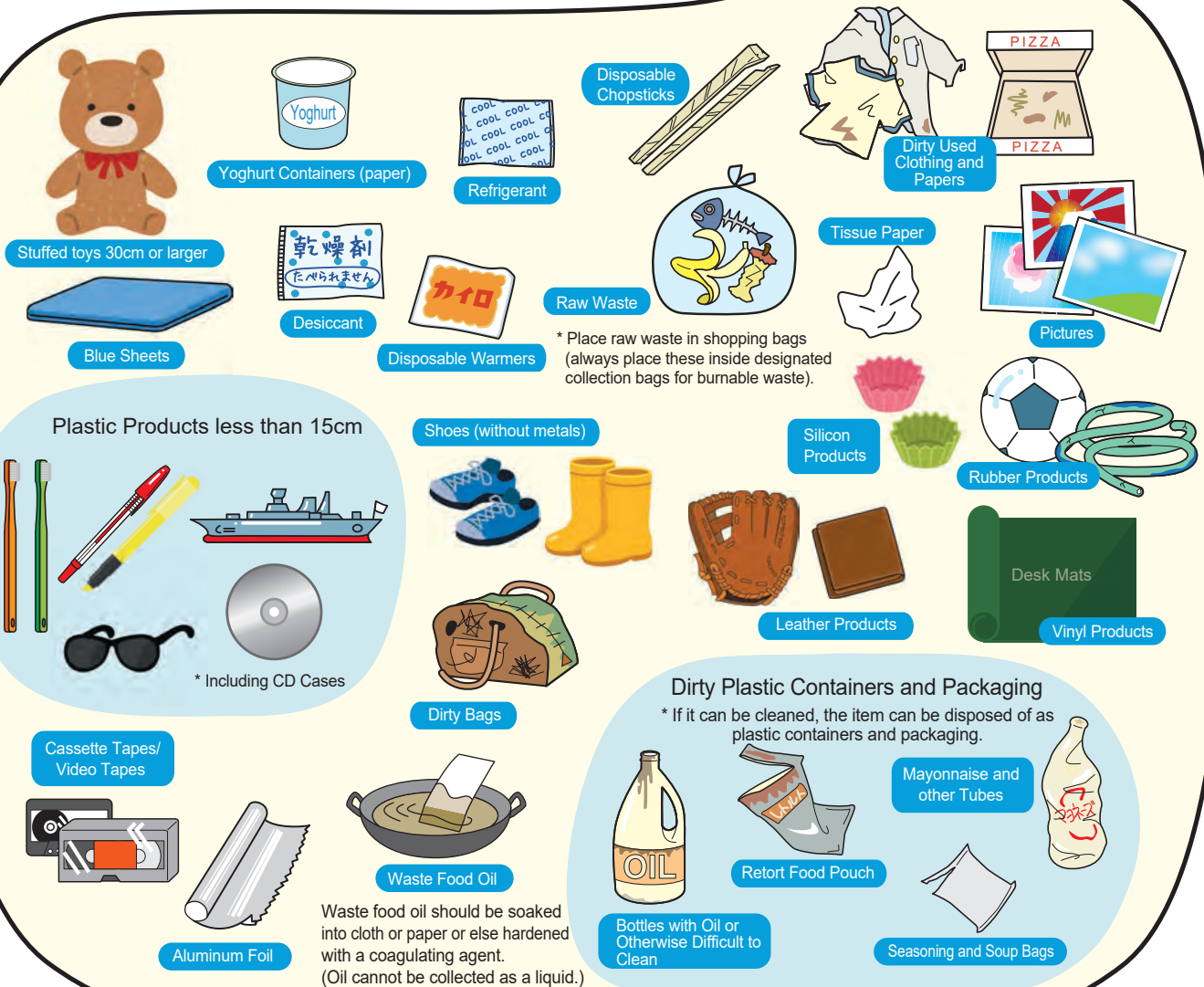

Disposing of Burnable Waste

Place in
yellow bags for
disposal.

Burnable waste includes raw waste, tissues, dirty plastic containers and packaging, leather products, vinyl products, rubber products (including silicon), and plastic products less than 15cm long. Remove all batteries.

Waste that does not fit in designated collection bags is oversized waste.

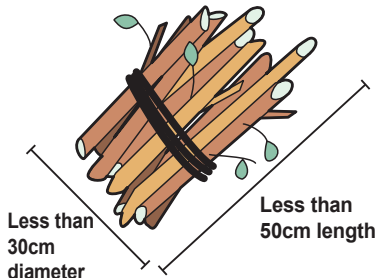




Branches, leaves and paper diapers are collected free on burnable waste days.

Except for branches, place in transparent or semi-transparent bags (shopping bags are allowed) for disposal. It is possible to dispose of up to 5 bags or 5 bundles of each type.

Branches (will be chipped to make resources)



Branches cut at home will be collected separately from burnable waste.

Bundle branches less than 10cm diameter as shown on the left with less than 50cm length and less than 30cm diameter.

* When disposing of 6 or more bundles of branches all together, or branches thicker than 10cm diameter or longer than 50cm, it is considered oversized waste.

Apply to the Kodaira City Oversized Waste Reception Center (TEL 03-5715-1774).

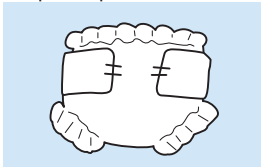
* For branches more than 20cm in diameter, contact the Resource Recycling Section.

* When requesting pruning from a contractor, ask them to take away the cuttings.

Paper Diapers

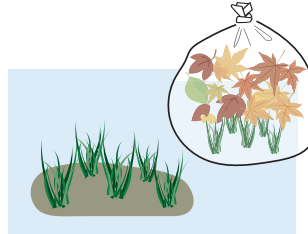
Remove all contents and flush in the toilet.

* Paper diapers should be placed in bags without anything else. Cloth diapers, diaper covers, feminine hygiene products, pet diapers or sheets and other similar items should be disposed of as burnable waste in designated collection bags.



Leaves and Grass

When hiring a contractor to collect grass clippings or leaves from a home, ask them to take away the collected waste.



Volunteer Cleaning Waste

Waste collected through volunteer cleaning activities are divided into burnable and non-burnable waste and then labelled with the volunteer labels distributed by the Roads Section, the Water, Greenery and Parks Section, or the Environmental Administration Section. (It is necessary to register in advance.)



Together we can reduce raw waste! 40 percent of burnable Waste is raw waste.

Reduce food loss

Check your fridge before shopping and only buy what you can eat.



Drain liquid from raw wastes

Simply squeezing in a net can reduce weight by 10 percent.



Collection of unused foods

Unopened cans or retort food packages and other non-perishable items (with a best by date of at least 1 month) are collected at the Kodaira Lifestyle Consultation Support Center (4F of the Fukushi Kaikan).



Food resources (raw waste) composter purchase subsidy

This subsidy is available for purchasing a food resources (raw waste) composter (half of the cost of purchase, home use maximum 30,000 yen, industrial use maximum 300,000 yen).



Food Material Recycling Project

Raw waste is collected once per week and used to make fertilizer. It is necessary to register a group in advance of at least three households and purchase a bucket with a lid (one per household).



Disposing of Home Medical Waste

Items to Dispose of as Burnable Waste

IV tubes, urine sampling bags and similar medical waste are burnable waste. Flush contaminants in the toilet.



Items to Return to the Issuing Medical Facility

Injection needles, syringes with needles and pen-type syringes are not collected by the city. Always return to a hospital or the pharmacy it was purchased from.



Caution



Waste that does not fit in designated collection bags such as bamboo shafts is oversized waste. When putting rod shaped items in designated collection bags by collapsing, always place in a bag and tie the mouth shut.

Ceramics, glass, plastic products larger than 15cm, and metallic articles are non-burnable waste. Remove all batteries. (Batteries may cause accidents.)

Waste that does not fit in designated collection bags is oversized waste.



* For items with a recyclable plastic mark, separate into plastic containers and packaging

Caution

Do not dispose of gas cartridge cans, spray cans, lighters, lithium ion batteries and digital tobacco as non-burnable waste.

* This has caused fires with collection vehicles.



Waste shaped like a pole such as an umbrella (less than 1m) should be placed in a designated bag that fits more than half of it inside and placed out ensuring that the opening is tied off.

Used Small Appliances

Box Collection

Future small appliances are collected and recycled at collection boxes installed at City Hall, the Tobu/Seibu Branch Offices, municipal libraries (Central, Kihei, Kamijuku, Tsuda, Onuma), Nakamachi Terrace, Suzuki Civic Hall and Kodaira City Recycle Center (only during open hours).

- Collection box insertion ports are vertical 11cm, horizontal 24cm.
- Dispose items that will not fit as non-burnable waste.
- Not collected items should be disposed of as normal waste.
- Reset information for products including personal information.
- Remove all batteries.

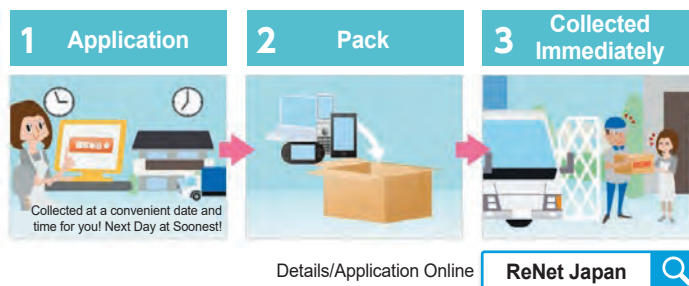

Collection by Delivery Service

Apply by internet to nationally certified contractor ReNet Japan (by computer or smartphone) and collect by courier on the desired date and time (next day minimum).

Fee: When computers are included and collection address is inside Kodaira City, one box for one collection is free (optional services are available for a fee).



Bring to the Recycle Caravan

Recycle Caravan determines the date/time and location about four times a year and there are collection sites for ceramic dishes, used small appliances, unused foods, waste food oil, etc.

* Ceramic dishes, small appliances, small rechargeable batteries, waste food oil, postcards and ink cartridges are collected at the Kodaira City Recycle Center during normal hours of operation. (Only when open)

Ceramic Dishes Ceramic dishes may be disposed of even if cracked or chipped. Items other than dishes (such as ashtrays or vases), glass items, articles that are used with direct flame (such as earthenware), items with stickers (except when removable) and dirty items (except when washable) are not collectable. We will ask you to take home your wrapping paper.

Small Appliances Items collected by box collection can also be collected by Recycle Caravan.

Waste Food Oil Vegetable oils used at home are covered regardless of whether they have been used or not. Oils other than animal oil or cooking oils are not allowed. Collected waste food oil will be made into BDG (biodiesel fuel).

Unused Foods Cans, retort food, pasta and other dried goods with a best-before period of more than one month (items requiring freezing or refrigeration, or items in jars are not permitted). Collected items will be used for meals at facilities like children's cafeterias in Kodaira. * Collection is always available at the Kodaira Lifestyle Consultation Support Center (Fukushi Kaikan 4F).

Used Ink Cartridges

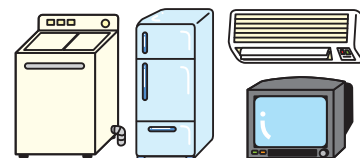
First-party cartridges from the following companies are collected at boxes in the City Hall and Kodaira City Recycle Center for recycling. (This only applies to home-use items. Broken cartridges are Burnable Waste.) * Toner cartridges are not included.

Brother, Canon, Dell, Seiko Epson, Japan HP

Items not Collected by the City

Disposing of Air Conditioners, TV, Fridges, Freezers, Laundry Machines and Clothes Dryers

- These items are not collected as oversized waste by the City.
- When purchasing a replacement, hire the seller to take away the older unit.
- When disposing of one of these items, hire a sales store to take it away.
- When the sales store is unknown or they cannot be hired to perform this service, use the following method to dispose of it.



Pay the Appliance Recycling Fee at the Japan Post Bank or Post Office (Savings Counter)

Depending on the manufacturer, the appliance recycling fee differs.
Confirm the name of the manufacturer and size in advance.

* All Japan Post Bank and Post Office (Savings Counter) locations in Japan handle this service.

Hire Transportation

Hire one of the collection and transportation contractors shown on the right or the Kodaira City Clean Business Association Business Center given below. (Fees will apply)

Disposal Method for Computers (either of the following two options)

- ① Used home use computers are collected by the manufacturer and recycled. Apply with the manufacturer of your computer.

For self-made computers or computers when the manufacturer is not known **i Pasokon 3R Suishin Kyokai ☎03(5282)7685**

For detailed information about disposal and amounts, inquire with the manufacturer or see the Pasokon 3R Suishin Kyokai website (<http://www.pc3r.jp/>).

- ② Apply by internet to nationally certified contractor ReNet Japan (see Page 19) (by computer or smartphone) and collect by courier on the desired date and time (next day minimum). It is not possible to apply by phone.

Fee: One box per collection is free (when the collection address is inside Kodaira City) * Optional services available for a fee. To apply or for more details, see the ReNet Japan website (<http://www.renet.jp/>).

Items not Handled by the City

- For items that cannot be handled at City facilities, hire a sales store or waste treatment contractor to take the items.
Batteries, tires, automotive parts, motorbikes (over 50cc), fire extinguishers, propane gas tanks, fire resistant safes, pianos, kerosene, chemicals, agrichemicals, construction waste, concrete, bricks, stones, sand, soil, etc.

Treatment of Business Waste

Business wastes (general business wastes) are recyclables and waste generated through the business activities of shops and companies. Business activities includes not only for-profit activities but also public projects and services such as education and welfare projects. Oversized and industrial business waste is not handled by the city. * For industrial wastes, hire a contractor licensed by the prefectural governor.

Businesses with Low Amounts of Waste (less than 10kg per day on average)

Purchase Kodaira City's designated collection bag for businesses and dispose of with city collection.

By purchasing designated collection bags, the disposal fee is paid. Place out separated on the day of the week designated by the city within the property of the place of business for collection by the City (contractor).




* To begin collection, contact the Resource Recycling Section two days before the start of collection not including weekends, holidays or New Years' holidays.

* Even businesses with low amounts of waste may choose to contract with a licensed collection and transportation contractor.

Types and Cost of Designated Bags

* Always write the name of the shop or place of business on the space provided on the bag or rope.

Disposal Locations

Place within the property limits of the business at the roadside. However, if there are special considerations such as locations that collection vehicles cannot enter or centralized collection for a shopping district, please consult in advance.

Collection Date/Separation Method

Separate and place out on the same day as household waste. When the store is also a residence, place business waste separate from household waste.

* Check the area collection calendar for the store to find out the collection date.

Businesses with High Amounts of Waste (more than 10kg per day on average)

Directly hire a collection and transportation contractor licensed by the City to handle the waste.

The collection method can be arranged with the contractor and the fee will be based on the amount being disposed of.

For details about separating and disposing of this waste, consult with the collection and transportation contractor before hiring them. Kodaira City has licensed the seven collection and transportation contractors on the right.

There are also licensed collection and transportation contractors outside of Kodaira. Check the City's website or contact the Resource Recycling Section for details.

Disposing of Oversized Waste

Oversized waste from businesses (companies, stores, municipalities, etc.) is not collected.

① Application

Service Counter Application

Come to the Resource Recycling Section service counter.

Reception time: Mondays to Fridays (excluding holidays and New Years holidays) 8:30 am to 5:00 pm

Internet Application

Apply via the Kodaira City website.

You can apply at any time except for when there is server maintenance.

Some items cannot be applied for online since details need to be confirmed.

* Measure the size of the object in advance.

* Various kinds of support are available to eliminate or reduce the cost of the oversized waste such as for persons receiving social welfare or households receiving child support subsidies. For details, information is available on the City website or by contacting the Resource Recycling Section.

② Purchase a Waste Treatment Label

● Purchase at stores that handle waste treatment labels listed on Page 5 to Page 7.

* When it is not clear which store that handles waste treatment labels is closest to you, you can get information when you apply.

At Repure Kodaira in the Kodaira City Recycle Center, oversized waste is refreshed and sold at low prices.

* Repure Kodaira does not receive oversized waste.

③ Affix a waste treatment label and place out inside your property

● Fill in your name and application date on the waste treatment label and affix it in an easily seen location.

● Place within your home's property limits at the roadside.

* **Dispose of waste at the central disposal location for housing complexes within the property limits.**



④ Collection

● Normally collection is the day after reception, or from within 2 to 4 days (excluding weekends and holidays).

● When applying online, you will be informed about the collection start date by a notification email.

● Collection can take place while you are away.

* The collection vehicle differs depending on the collected object. When it cannot all be collected.

* During busy periods such as New Years, it may take a few days until collection.

In this case, applying for oversized waste and the waste treatment label will not be necessary.

* Separate by kind of material and place in designated collection bags. Always tie the opening and place out on the collection date.

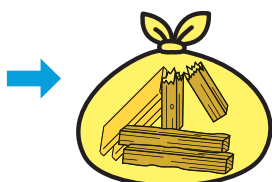
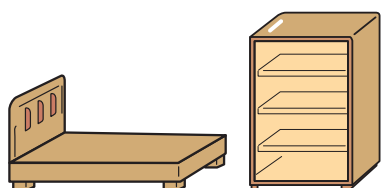
* To prevent bags from bursting, avoid filling with more weight than can be easily held in one hand.

* Remove all batteries.

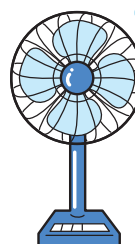
* Stoves, fan heaters and other items that can generate heat or flame must be disposed of as oversized waste.

Recycling and Waste Disposal Rules

- **Recycling and waste must be placed out on the morning of the collection day by 8am. Collection is performed even on holidays, except for New Years holidays.**
 - * Putting out waste on days other than the collection day is illegal littering, may be spread by crows or cats, can cause odors and otherwise cause problems in your neighborhood. Only dispose of recycling and waste on the determined collection date.
 - * Collection time may vary based on the traffic conditions, weather and amount of recycling or waste being placed out. Always put out your waste by 8am.
- **Place waste out inside the property at an easily checked space such as by the roadside. Always place waste out in the same location, even when it rains.**
 - * Thank you for helping prevent waste not being seen when collecting.
- **Always tie the top after putting recyclables and waste in bags to prevent visibility of the contents.**
 - * To prevent bags from bursting, avoid filling with more weight than can be easily held in one hand.
 - * Make bundles of magazines, books, mixed papers, newspaper, leaves and grass at weights that can be held with one hand.
- **Burnable waste, non-burnable waste and plastic containers and packaging must be collected in designated collection bags.**
 - * Waste that does not fit in designated collection bags must be disposed of as oversized waste.
 - * All other items are separated by type and placed in transparent or semi-transparent bags or tied into bundles. (Some items may be placed directly in baskets or buckets. For details see pages 8 to 10.)
- **Disposing of a large amount of recyclables or waste all at once can interfere with collection on that day. Consider ways you can reduce the amount of recyclables and waste and plan your waste disposal. Aim for up to 5 bags or bundles per type per collection.**



Kodaira City Garbage Separation App

Kodaira City has made a Garbage Separation App (free to install) available for smartphones and tablets.

Get various kinds of information about wastes and simply find out information about events. It also has convenient features including a waste collection calendar, waste separation dictionary and instructions for disposing of waste.
